
Foot Shear Safety Rules



- Do not use the jump shear unless you have been trained and have the permission of the teacher.
- 2. Keep the work area clean and free of scrap pieces of metal.
- 3. Be sure all guards are in place and in good working order.
- Never stand on the foot pedal with both feet. Keep one foot on the ground at all times to maintain your balance.
- 5. Never jump on the pedal to make a cut.
- 6. Keep hands and fingers away from the blade and behind the hold-down.
- 7. Keep all body parts out of the way of all moving parts. Avoid pinch points.
- 8. Never exceed the rated capacity / gauge of the foot shear.
- 9. Use the foot shear for the purpose is was designed. DO NOT cut round stock!
- 10. Do not cut out-of-position. Avoid awkward operations and hand positions where a sudden slip could cause your hand or body to fall into a sharp edge or the machine.
- 11. Do not overreach. Maintain your balance at all times.
- 12. Check for damaged parts before using the machinery. Report any problems immediately!




Figure 1. Identification.
